In line with mandatory and advisory Scottish Government requirements, we have a number of protective measures in place to help reduce the spread of COVID-19.



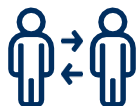
FACE COVERINGS

Face coverings should always be worn when indoors, unless a person is exempt. This includes while seated, moving around and queuing at the catering station. Face coverings can be removed while eating and drinking.



VENTILATION

Increase air circulation by opening windows, doors and vents. Make sure to take regular fresh air breaks throughout your event. If your location does not have operational windows or doors, ensure sufficient mechanical ventilation is available and working.



RESPECTFUL DISTANCING

To ensure all guests feel comfortable at your event, we encourage guests to maintain a respectful distance from each other and the Delivered Hospitality team. It is also important that the number of guests is appropriate and proportionate to the size of the room.



CHECK IN SCOTLAND

NHS Test & Protect data will be captured via the Check In Scotland app as guests enter the Delivered Hospitality catering room. We recommend you capture these details at the start of your event.



HYGIENE MEASURES

We provide hand sanitisers at your catering station. All our delivery vehicles are equipped with a travel hygiene kit and are sanitised regularly.



FOOD & BEVERAGE

We adhere to strict health and safety measures when preparing and serving food. Menus and service options have been modified in order to reduce contact points.
